

# Worship with us in the Word:

## *God's Amazing Actions Towards Our Sin*

### **1. He forgives our transgression (Ps. 32:1, 5).**

*Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. <sup>2</sup> Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.*

### **2. He covers our sin (Ps. 32:1; Rom. 4:7).**

*Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered*

*Romans 4:6-8 – “just as David also speaks of the blessing of the one to whom God counts righteousness apart from works: 7 “Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered;*

*8 blessed is the man against whom the Lord will not count his sin.”*

### **3. He does not charge us with iniquity (Ps. 32:2; Rom. 4:8).**

*“Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity...”*

### **4. He removes our sins from us (Ps. 103:12; John 1:29).**

*Psalms 103:12 “as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.*

### **5. He throws all our sins behind His back (Isa. 38:17).**

*“...but in love you have delivered my life from the pit of destruction, for you have cast all my sins behind your back.”*

### **6. He sweeps away our transgressions (Isa 44:22; Psalm 51:1).**

*I have blotted out your transgressions like a cloud and your sins like mist; return to me, for I have redeemed you.*

### **7. He remembers our sins no more (Isa. 43:25; Jer. 31:34; Heb. 8:12; 10:16-17).**

*“I, I am he who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins.*

*Hebrews 8:12 - For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.”*

### **8. He casts all our sins into the depths of the sea (Mic. 7:18-19).**

*Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love. <sup>19</sup> He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot.*

*You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.*

### **9. He washes away our guilt and cleanses us from our sin (Ps. 51:2; Isa. 1:18; 1 John 1:9).**

*Ps. 51:2 - Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!*

### **10. He nailed our sin debt to the cross (Col. 2:13, 14).**

*And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, <sup>14</sup> by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nauling it to the cross.*
