1. **The Truth** about God: He controls everything.
  
2. **The Truth** about Suffering:
  - Some is self-inflicted, much is not.
  
  - God uses it for long-term good. *Romans 8:28, Genesis 50:19-21*
  
3. **The Truth** about Ourselves
  - Our perspective is limited by time and focus. *Isaiah 55:8,9*
  
  - It's more than we don't see it; we cannot see it.
  
4. **The Truth** about Our Choices *Psalms 14:1, Matthew 6:25-32*
  
5. **The Truth** of God's Promises *Isaiah 41:10, Hebrews 13:5, 1 Peter 5:7*

**The Lie:** I cannot be a good Christian and have doubts.

- Our struggle with doubts happens because of faith, not due to its absence. *Mark 9*
  
- Faith is unique to our time on earth. *Hebrews 11:1, 2 Corinthians 5:7*
