“The Lord Has Need of It” – Perspectives for Palm Sunday

Mark 11:1-11

Palm Branches, a Donkey, and Praise... and church traditions

Your challenge today: bring a spirit of investigation to the familiar.

1. The Perspective of Jesus' Action – Mark 11:1-6
 - It was deliberate.
 - It was dramatic.
 - It was dangerous.
2. The Perspective of the Crowd's Reaction - Mark 11:7-10
 - They had passion and extravagance.
 - They had definite expectations – some based upon Scripture!
 - They were marred by confusion.

The Final Scene – end of the day – Mark 11:11

3. The Perspective of Our Response
 - How do I respond when I learn that ‘the Lord has need of (something) I possess?
 - I am quite similar to the crowd at Bethany: expectations, concerns, & desires
 - I must understand Jesus, the Messiah from Scripture, not from our American perspective.
