#### 1 Samuel 23-24

#### Scene 1 – Deliverance at Keilah – vv. 1-14

- David's active role - done through God's enablement
- David's passive role - done by God's direction

#### **Learning from David's actions:**

- Without God's help, human effort and information are flawed and unreliable.
- Do not be deterred with negative advice or reactions when God's instruction is known.

#### **Learning from Saul's action:**

- Do not assume the convenient circumstances automatically indicate "the Lord's will."

#### Scene 2 – Encouragement at Horesh – vv. 15-18

- Jonathan's presence & words
- Jonathan's confidence and the renewed covenant

#### Scene 3 – Intervention in the Wilderness of Maon - vv. 19-29

- Saul plays the victim, but implements a solid plan
- God's silent hand protects
- David's recognition of God's hand –

#### **Learning from God's actions here:**

- Remember that God's plan for you cannot be thwarted even when it your circumstances point in an overwhelming negative direction.
