The Cry from the Cross – “FINISHED!”
Hebrews 10:1-18

“Finished”... context makes all the difference

Hebrews 10 – The Finished Work of Christ

The Defects of the OT Sacrifices – vv. 1-4

- Foreshadowed what was to come
- Limited – only provided ‘present’ forgiveness

The Wonder of Christ’s Sacrifice – vv. 5-9

- Superior to sacrifices, offerings, burnt offerings, and sin offerings
- Christ’s superior actions display His sinless will and motivation!

The Achievement of Christ’s Sacrifice – vv. 10-14

- It provided all that sin demanded.
- It provided all that mankind needed... including those under the first covenant (Heb. 9:15)
- It provided all that God required.

The Spirit’s Witness of Christ’s Sacrifice – vv. 15-18

- Through the Word of God – Jeremiah 31:33-34
- Through the heart of the believer

The promise is given again: “I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more.”

The “*Finished!*” cry from the cross is one of victory; complete forgiveness of these removes the need for any sin offering.
