Worship with us in the Word

Nehemiah – Getting on to God’s Agenda
Rebuilding the People of God
Nehemiah 5:14 – 7:4

Nehemiah consolidates and delegates – 7:1-4.

- Why? He knew the wall construction was not 'the end'.
- Who? He enlisted and appointed people of character.

The People congregate and celebrate – 8:1-12.

- They gathered expectantly. (v. 1-2)
- They listened attentively. (vv. 3-5)
- They responded physically. (vv. 6-9)
- They celebrated joyfully. (vv. 10-12)

You, in coming together for corporate worship should follow the same four steps as God’s people did in Nehemiah 8.
