Worship with us in the Word

Simply The Best—A Study in Hebrews Deity with Humanity – Necessary for Salvation Hebrews 2:1-18 Pastor Jack Austin

The Problem – To help Christians, who were tempted to deconstruct their faith because of doubts about Jesus, to remain true to their confession because of God's plan and promise

Evangelical Deconstructionism today...

Danger: Watch for Drifting! 2:1-4

- It involves <u>neglecting</u> the Word rather than <u>rejecting</u> the Word.
- It involves <u>believers</u> rather than <u>non-believers</u>.
- Be alert drifting <u>off course</u> is typically seen as getting <u>on course</u> by non-believers.

His humanity enabled Jesus...

- To regain man's <u>original dominion</u> vv. 5-9
- To bring "many sons to glory." vv. 10-13
- To disarm the devil and deliver us from slavery to sin. vv. 14-16
- To be a sympathetic High Priest to His people. vv. 17-18

But why was Jesus' exaltation preceded by His death?

Reason #1- Because it was 'fitting' and necessary – 2:10, 17

Reason #2 – Because of God's <u>plan</u> and His promise – 2:11, 16

Questions to consider:

- 1. What various forms can 'neglecting' our walk with God take?
- 2. What actions can you take to guard against drifting off course spiritually?
- 3. Since Jesus disarmed the devil through His death (v. 14), what are the practical implications for fighting "transgressions or actions of disobedience" (v.2)?
