Discipleship Basics - Passing the Mantle - Part 2

The Mentor or Discipler must be committed.

- 1. Be committed to a person... not a project... not a duty.
 - Keep his/her bests interests in mind.
 - Actively value him/her.

This requires our diligence!

- 2. Be committed to a process.
 - Assess the present reality of the disciple/protégé.
 - Identify the incremental steps needed yet understand the big picture of his/her life.

This requires our discernment!

- 3. Be committed to a purpose.
 - Recognize God's pattern with us. Phil. 1:6
 - Define the end goal with your disciple/protégé.

This requires our determination!

The Mentor or Discipler must gain authority to speak.

- 1. Gaining this authority does not come easily or naturally.
- 2. To have authority means to carry "influence" with another.
- 3. How does one earn deep influence in a disciple's life? First, think of the influential people in your past. Secondly, try to identify how they gained influence in your life.

Tools for Gaining Influence with a Disciple/Protégé

- I INVEST in the person.
- N Be NATURAL with the person.
- F Have FAITH in the person
- L LISTEN attentively to the person.
- U Be UNDERSTANDING of the person's life/situation
- E Give ENCOURAGEMENT to the person regularly.
- N- NAVIGATE willingly for the person when needed.
- C Display CONCERN for the person
- E Display ENTHUSIASM over the person
