God's Amazing Actions Towards Our Sin

1. He forgives our transgression (Ps. 32:1, 5).

Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. ² Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

2. He covers our sin (Ps. 32:1; Rom. 4:7).

Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered

Romans 4:6-8 – “just as David also speaks of the blessing of the one to whom God counts righteousness apart from works: ⁷ “Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered;

8 blessed is the man against whom the Lord will not count his sin.”

3. He does not charge us with iniquity (Ps. 32:2; Rom. 4:8).

“Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity...”

4. He removes our sins from us (Ps. 103:12; John 1:29).

Psalm 103:12 “as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

5. He throws all our sins behind His back (Isa. 38:17).

“...but in love you have delivered my life from the pit of destruction, for you have cast all my sins behind your back.”

6. He sweeps away our transgressions (Isa 44:22; Psalm 51:1).

I have blotted out your transgressions like a cloud and your sins like mist; return to me, for I have redeemed you.

7. He remembers our sins no more (Isa. 43:25; Jer. 31:34; Heb. 8:12; 10:16-17).

“I, I am he who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

Hebrews 8:12 - For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.”

8. He casts all our sins into the depths of the sea (Mic. 7:18-19).

Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love. ¹⁹ He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot.

You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

9. He washes away our guilt and cleanses us from our sin (Ps. 51:2; Isa. 1:18; 1 John 1:9).

Ps. 51:2 - Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!

10. He nailed our sin debt to the cross (Col. 2:13, 14).

And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, ¹⁴ by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailed it to the cross.
