The Observations from Saul

- 1. Fear Caused Irrational Thinking
 - My assumptions are right regardless of the facts/evidence.
 - It is possible to work around God.
- 2. Fear Caused Unbiblical Actions... Disobedience
 - Using and excusing desired actions expressly prohibited by God
 - Involving others in disobedience... expecting their support
- 3. Unchecked Fear & Disobedience... Costly Consequences
 - No guidance from God/unanswered prayer see also Psalm 66: 18
 - Loss of blessing and enablement his kingdom and leadership
