

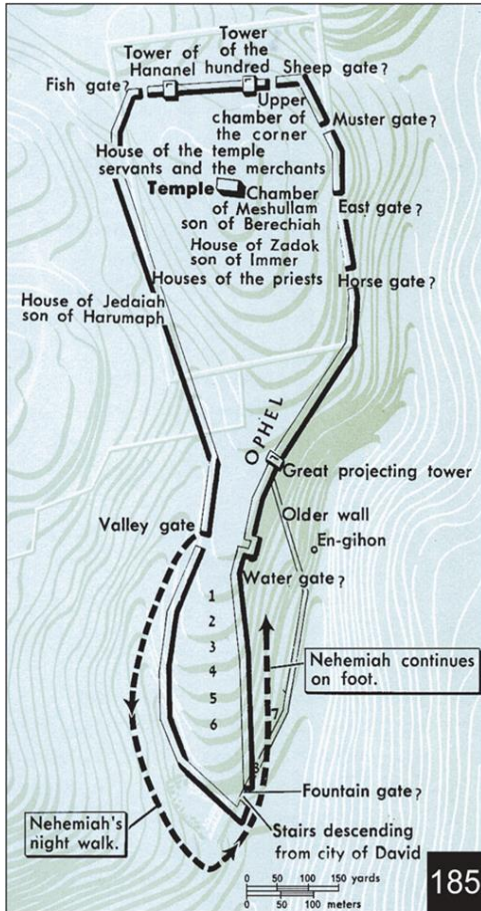

Five "Drone Observations" from Nehemiah 3



1. The mission required the active involvement of the entire community.
2. Participation of the community needed to be immediate and harmonious.
3. The mission could only be accomplished through dedication and enthusiasm.
4. The mission used very diverse teams of people as opposed to identical teams.
5. The project faced interference and resistance.

A Key Perspective Then & Now: Interdependence rather than independence

Opposition comes when God's people are on God's agenda – Nehemiah 4:1-6

- Ridicule by others – vv.1-3
- Reaction of God's people – vv. 4-5
- Rebuilding continues – but only half of its height! - v. 6
