

Five "Drone Observations" from Nehemiah 3



- 1. The mission required the <u>active involvement</u> of the entire community.
- 2. Participation of the community needed to be <u>immediate</u> and <u>harmonious</u>.
- 3. The mission could only be accomplished through <u>dedication</u> and <u>enthusiasm</u>.
- 4. The mission used very <u>diverse</u> teams of people as opposed to <u>identical</u> teams.
 - 5. The project faced <u>interference</u> and <u>resistance</u>.

A Key Perspective Then & Now: Interdependence rather than independence

Opposition comes when God's people are on God's agenda - Nehemiah 4:1-6

- Ridicule by others vv.1-3
- Reaction of God's people vv. 4-5
- Rebuilding continues but only half of its height! v. 6
