The Incognito Christ.... Believing is Seeing!

Luke 24:13-35

An encounter with Christ rarely happens through a Damascus Road experience. It almost universally happens through an Emmaus Road experience of meeting Him in the ordinary routine of life.

The two men possessed a basic problem. (13-24)

- Struggling to make sense of <u>unmet expectations.</u>
- "Our hope was dead and buried."

The two men received the big picture. (vv. 25-27)

- They weren't <u>unbelievers</u>, but rather <u>improper</u> believers.
- Talking about Jesus provided no <u>real hope</u>.
- Jesus provided the big picture: <u>The Scriptures.</u>

The two men experienced a 'belief' perspective. (vv. 28-35)

- The invitation to Christ Who was responsible for this?
- The <u>recognition</u> of Christ Who was responsible for this?
- The celebration concerning Christ.

Are you 'in Christ' today?

- If so, you can undoubtedly point to these same three elements in your life.
- If unsure, you can invite Christ to enter your life, recognize Him as Scripture declares Him to be, and celebrate with all those who have been redeemed!
