Truth never changes...but it isn't always believed.

"Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth." – John 17:17

Building on Truth Requires Diligence – 2 Timothy 2:14-16

- To avoid the foolish issues.
- To prioritize the Word of Truth

Building on Truth Requires Correction – 2 Timothy 2:24-25

- Display gentleness amid opposition
 - Misunderstanding
 - Tiredness or fatigue
 - Emotional distance
- Guard against selective correction

Building on Truth Requires Relationship – 2 Timothy 3:14-17

- With the other person
- With the Author of the Word

Practical Ideas to Build on Truth

- Set a specific time for Bible reading and prayer with others – even one other person.
- Memorize a portion of the Word with others.
- Have a contest to learn the books of the Bible. Remember – contests often have prizes!
- Read through the Bible in a year. Listen to dramatized audio versions of the Bible.
- Choose some family/household values and post them in the home.
- Talk regularly about what you are learning about God and His Word – from ABF/SS, sermons, and your recent personal reading.
- Parents, don't just pray with your kids before bed, but read a portion of God's Word... with enthusiasm!
