- 1. Manipulative judgement isn't the "justice" God had in mind
 - a. Manipulative judgement:
 - i. Based on little investigation
 - ii. Twisted to fit an agenda
 - iii. Selectively applied
 - iv. Disregards our own sin
 - Considering our sin:
 - a. Humbles us Matt. 7:1-5

John 7:24

- b. Allows us to see the person Phil. 2:1-8
- c. Moves us towards <u>desiring</u> restoration Matt. 18:15-16

instead of seeking retribution

- a. Slow down and ask yourself some questions
 - i. Do I know all the important details?
 - ii. Do I have a bias or agenda that will lead me to do this poorly?
 - iii. Am I imbalanced with how I'm weighing this?
 - iv. With my sin in view, how can I approach this with humility?

 - a. A guilty woman
 - b. A merciful God
