 - Uniquely equipped through the Spirit

2. Why is life *better* for those who are connected?
 - It is obedience in action.

 - It protects us from our blind spots and flaws
 - It provides what we're lacking individually

3. What does it look like?
 - John 1:35-42 – within our immediate circles
 - John 6:5-14 – across the age groups
